This Week's Program

Michael Parent is the owner of Utica Club & Jam Vintage USA. Originally from Chazy, New York, he attended SUNY Plattsburgh and graduated in December 2019. Prior to graduating and immediately after, Michael worked at a tech nonprofit. After the start of the pandemic, he took the plunge and opened his first retail vintage clothing store in July 2020. After two years, he moved to Utica to open Utica Vintage Club where he specializes in selling vintage clothing, records, and rare books.

Michael says one of the driving forces behind his love for vintage comes from the nostalgia that a single item can bring—a record with your favorite song, a t-shirt from your favorite vacation destination, or that first edition book you've been searching for. Another reason behind his affinity for vintage goods comes from the sustainability of buying vintage and second-hand. Every time an item is bought, repurposed, or recycled, the item is saved from being sent to a landfill. For example, 85 percent of all clothing produced ends up in a landfill or is burned!
