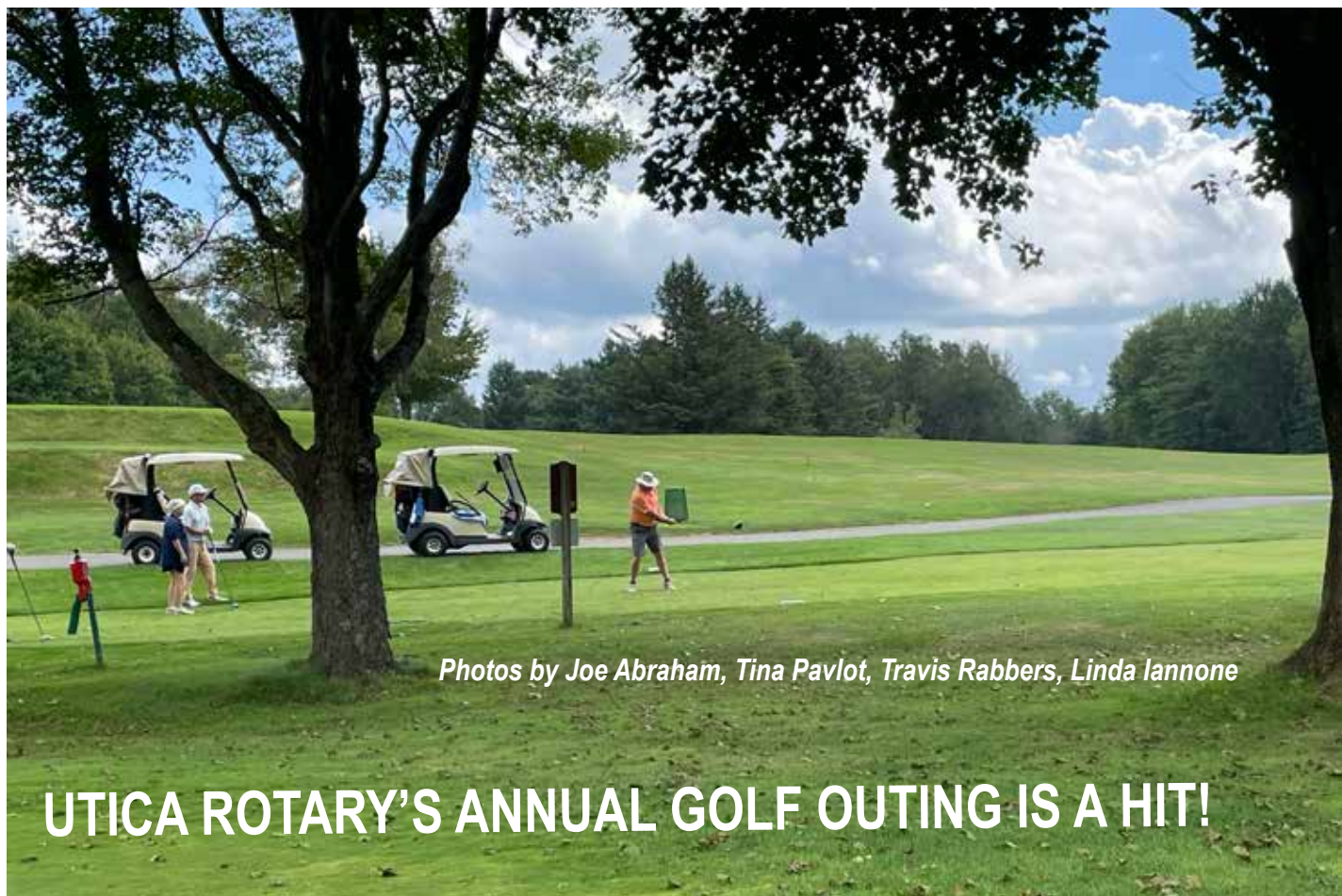
Rotarians volunteer at United Games
