MUCC explains that governmental support extends for just 90 days upon refugees' arrival, with many grappling with persistent language barriers, economic hardship, trauma-related challenges, and cultural nuances long after resettlement.

MUCC steps in to address these issues, offering extended support to empower refugees in accessing essential resources and integrating into their new home.
