RAISE YOUR ROTARY IQ AT 'ROTARY LEARNING INSTITUTE'

With that in mind, I urge Rotarians to attend the upcoming Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI) event on March 1, 2025, in Johnson City, NY.

Our current CNY Rotary President, Lizzy Martin, along with the Executive Board, strongly believes in the value of this program. As such, we have asked the District Leadership to subsidize this event and they have agreed to reduce costs for all Level 1 participants to \$25, even if you are repeating the course.
