This month Rotary Club of Utica has several ways for you to help in our community. We hope you can join us in one or more of the following service projects:

- **11/16: Utica Tree Project Tree Planting** -Planting will take place starting at 9 a.m., rain or shine. Three teams of three to four persons are needed. With at least nine volunteers, planting should be done by noon. Volunteers will meet at 922 Saratoga Street, at which time they will be given an orientation on planting and then break into three groups to plant about five trees at three residences.
