The featured speaker for our meeting this Thursday, Nov. 6, is Dr. Anshu Chandra, who has worked in Haiti for the last 15 years building and advancing eye care for the poor.

The meeting starts at noon at the Mid-York Library headquarters, 1600 Lincoln Ave., Utica. The optometrist is working to end disparities in eye care globally by bringing this service to remote areas.

She holds a Doctor of Optometry degree and did her residency at SUNY College of Optometry in New York. She was raised in India and the USA.
