What are the characteristics of this medium?... rare, valuable, chemically stable, malleable and identifiable. Gold works best as a useful medium of exchange. Eventually coins were developed. In England, 1600's the first central bank was created and paper money was made. World trade began and the Amsterdam Bank did worldwide business. Over the years various currencies were the world standard and at this time, the Dollar is the official world reserve standard. After WW2, England and France started to redeem their notes for gold. In 1971 Nixon announced that there will be no more redemption. Other countries started making their own money.
