Speaker; Destinee Udelhoven, Executive Director of the Mount Horeb Area Historical Society telling of the progress of the new museum.

The project came about due to the lack of storage for the artifacts. Humidity and climate control was needed. Last year Destinee came to talk with us needing \$3000,000 to match from an anonymous donor, which has since been raised.. Ground breaking was June 4th 2016. Things are stored in semi's and spaces around town. The Troll Inn came down in early May. The existing museum had to be insulated. In July a privy was found and was documented by Johnna. The hardware store/museum was completely gutted. In August, the concrete slabs were poured and the parking lot was built. The utility commission gave permission to move power that was on a telephone pole to underground. Framing of the new building began in September. A sculpture by John Pahlas was hung in October but is under wraps. It became clear that the façade of the hardware store was falling apart so non-budgeted repairs were done. She showed some interior shots but didn't want to show too much so that we will all be surprised at the grand opening the weekend of June 3rd.
