

# Rotary Grant Request 2023/2024 Funding Requests October 1, 2023 – March 31, 2024

Rotary is a global network of 1.4 million neighbors, friends, leaders, and problem-solvers who see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change – across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves. Rotary members contribute their skills, expertise, and resources to help solve some of the world's toughest problems locally and internationally. From providing local community food pantry support to preventing blindness in India, **Rotary Club of Mount Horeb Grants** bring service project ideas to life both locally and afar; both big and small.

#### **Grant Guidelines**

The Mount Horeb Rotary Club has changed its policy to solicit funding requests from organizations from one month a year to continuously accepting applications throughout the year. However, to receive the current fiscal year's funds, applications must be submitted prior to March 31<sup>st</sup> to be considered. Applications submitted after April 1<sup>st</sup> will be considered in the following Rotary fiscal year (July 1 – June 30). All funds will be distributed before the end of the fiscal year. This change is to help the Rotary Club of Mount Horeb be able to see annual grant opportunities within the community which can double or quadruple the budgeted giving utilizing the full financial power of the Rotary Foundation(s).

The Rotary Club of Mount Horeb has budgeted \$14,485 for Direct Community Giving and Rotary Grants for its 2023/2024 fiscal year. Although historically the club has preferred to spread its support among several organizations, the entire budgeted amount could be awarded to one cause with the highest impact, or any amount may be held over for the next fiscal year's giving.

#### **Grant Policies**

Annual funding requests are awarded by the Mount Horeb Rotary Club to those groups (including but not restricted to not-for-profit organizations exempted by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code) in alignment with Rotary's Mission. Funding requests may be made by groups or individuals that require financial support for a project or service that advances and enriches the common welfare of their community and aligns with Rotary's mission\*. In no case does funding one year assure funding in the next. Any application submitted prior to March 31st will require a new application for the next year.

**Application Deadlines** - All funds are awarded annually.

March 31, 2024 All requests for funding this fiscal year are due by this date. April 30, 2024 Award recipients notified by letter on or before this date.

May 29, 2024 Award Ceremony will be held during Evening Rotary Presentation
