Membership process for Rotary Club of New Braunfels

- Fill out the application form and return it/email it to the Club Membership Chair (link on the website). No payment is due.
- You will be invited to an "interview" with a membership committee member and your sponsor where Rotary and our club's requirements will be discussed. Your application will be submitted to the RCoNB Membership Committee then to the Board of Directors for review and approval. Afterwards, there will be two consecutive Wednesday "readings" before the membership. This is about a 1 month process from submittal to induction.
- Once past the two readings, the prospective member will be invited to a regular Wednesday meeting for "induction" into the club.

New Member Obligations and Expectations:

- Expect annual membership to cost approximately \$1,000-\$1,200. Beginning July 1, 2019, all new members will be billed for their meals through the end of the current quarter. Members are billed quarterly for dues and meals. Timely payment upon quarterly receipt of invoice for meals and dues = approximately \$250-300 per quarter ---includes prepayment of meals.
- Attendance: No less than 50%. Make-ups for missed meeting can be accomplished by attending any other Rotary Club meeting (Downtown Rotary meets on Thursdays), by attending a monthly board meeting or club social, or by completing an e-club meeting. No other make-ups will be accepted unless explicitly approved by the RCoNB Board. -Make-ups are good for two weeks before/after the make-up date.
- Commitment to work at our major club community events: November's Wurstfest, and the Hill Country Craft Beer Festival in the Spring.
- As a new member you will receive a RED name badge. You should work toward earning your WHITE name badge by attending a board meeting, Fireside Chat, a New Member social, creating and updating Club Runner with your picture and info, and a work service shift. Work with your sponsor/Membership chair to find out more.
- We meet every Wednesday (except holidays or otherwise noted) from about noon until 1 pm at the Columbus Club Hall on Landa across from the Wurstfest Grounds. Meetings start promptly at 12:05 pm.
- Our club is a community service club and has value for networking and business and personal relationship-building. We do not actively promote our business during lunch meetings. We do not offer "business category exclusivity" for our members.
