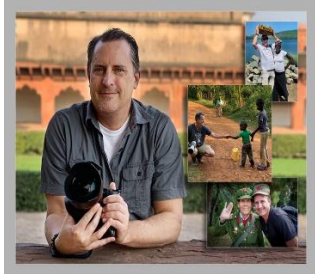


Lisa Jaster – Civil Engineering

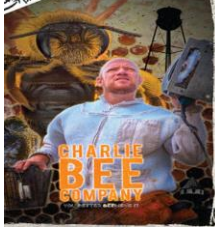
