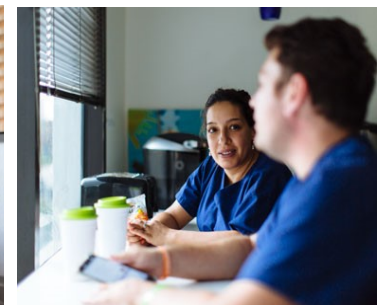
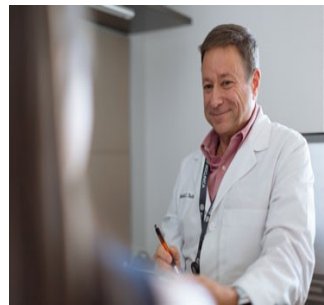
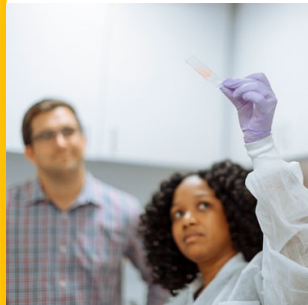

Cameron of Bioclinica Research talked about some of the steps that are taken when carrying out a trial for a new medicine. Or testing reactions to a new procedure:

1> **Pre Clinical : Drugs are administrated during an overnight stay to a small group of volunteers.**

2> Then it goes to a larger number of volunteers for a number of years all are to check reactions and effectiveness of drug.

3> An even larger group is tested for a few more years.

It takes approximately \$650 Million Dollars to test a drug over as much as a 10 year period then on to the government entity for evaluation.

For their trials there are 4 stages of trials :

1> Screening

2> Diagnostic

3> Preintervention

4>Treatment Trials

They would like volunteers for some of these and other trials they are working on, however there are things to be considered.

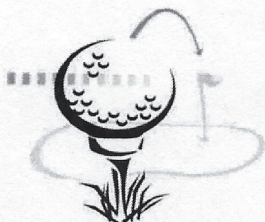

There are only 33 cards on the table, that is all that is left between you and the pot. Today the draw was not the Joker, the Joker is waiting for you next week.

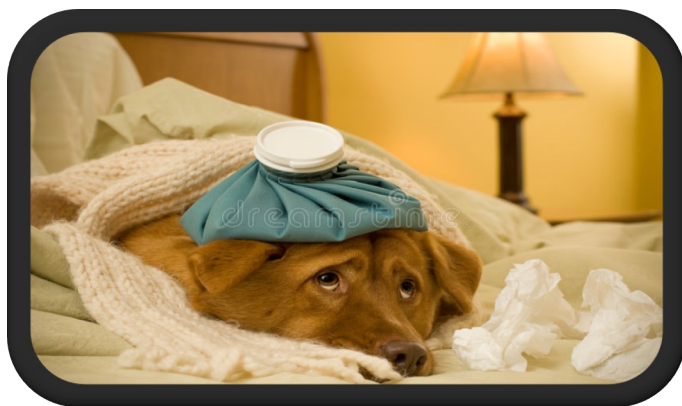
