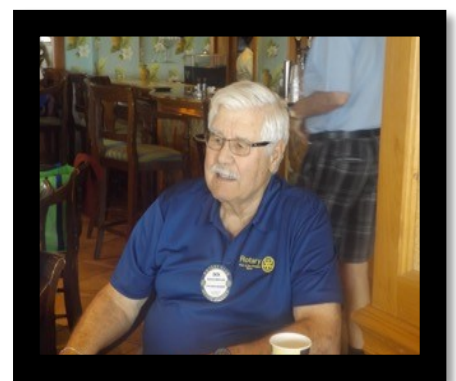
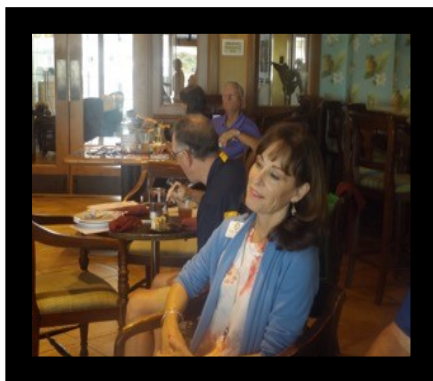
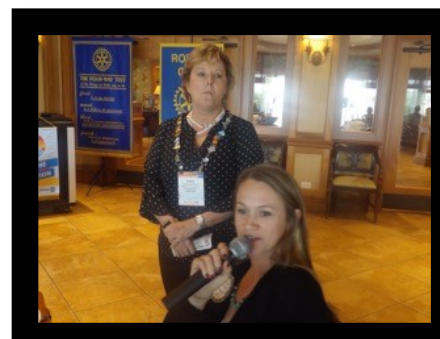
President-Elect Danielle, standing in for President Ray , Leads us in the pledge of allegiance to open the meeting and the reciting of the “four way test” to close.

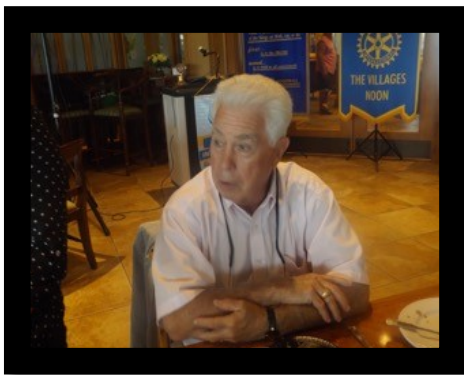
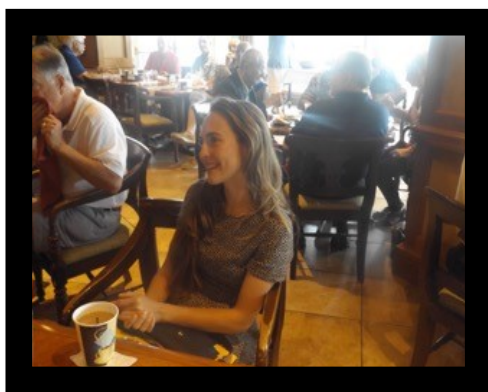

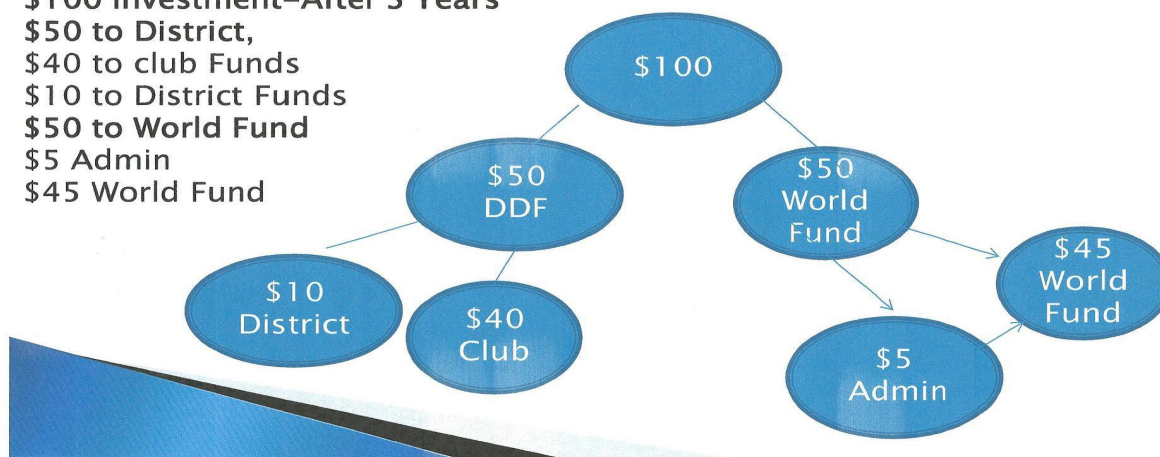
