Our speaker today was The honorable Judge Paul Militello , who lead us down the “us down the yellow brick road” with a in-sightful talk on the workings of the role of a Judge. He told us that a Judge only carries out the letter of the law and can not vary from the way the law is written, he can not give advice or change or make up the law. The Judge also told us that a judge can not be politicly bias. Judge Militello was appointed by then Governor Rick Scott in February of 2016, he had served as prosecutor from 1993-to 1997, he then went into private practice till appointed Judge.

Judge Militello handles all misdemeanor matters , including criminal traffic offenses , all cival traffic matters , small claims court, small claims cases and all county civil claims ranging from \$5,000.00 to \$15,000.00. He is credited with the creation of the Veterans Court here in Sumpter County. He also handles both the drug court docket and the Veteran's court dockets, along with all county court dockets as well. We appreciate him giving his time , with all that he has going on.
