The speaker today was Glenn Stein, the owner of Realty Executives in the Villages. He started in real estate in 2000 and has sold over 1,000 properties. He became a broker in 2004 and built Realty Executives, which has 80 agents with a gross volume of \$350 Million dollars Glenn has been a Rotarian since 1997 and is the past President of the Ocala Rotary Club ( which is the oldest club in Florida), he also served as Past area Governor for District 6970.

He talked about how it use to be that the best time to sell in the area was during the season, but now that the population has grown, any time is a good time to market your home. He talked about how prices on homes above Route 44 are more likely to increase.

He said that new homes resale are often slower to increase, the number of days on the market for resale in The Villages is 19-59 days. He is seen here receiving his certificate, that lets him know that as part of our assistance to the Anti Bulling program, a donation is made in his name, with a photo and name being sent to the Moon.

(*The Villages, FL*) July 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 — Last week The Rotary Club of The Villages Noon took their first photo that will be sent to the moon. In partnership with the *Pledge Against Bullying*, a program run and operated by students in Leesburg, FL., and under the leadership of Rotarian David van de Velde, a digital photo of each of our speakers will be launched into space in the fall of 2020 in a Falcon Heavy Rocket. The launch of the rocket is part of the Moon Landing project. Supporters of the Anti-Bullying campaign can make a contribution and in turn send data to the moon. It was a unique and creative way to bring awareness to the anti-bullying campaign, as well as raise funds to support the *Pledge Against Bullying*.

After hearing a presentation on the anti-bullying campaign, the Rotary Club of The Villages Noon wanted to get involved and started brainstorming on ways to help out. This July 1<sup>st</sup> marked the change of leadership for the Rotary Club of The Villages Noon, along with over 33,000 Rotary clubs amongst 200 countries, as it is the start of their new fiscal year. Excited by the success of the anti-bullying campaign and the impact it is making on local students lives, the new Board of Directors decided to thank every speaker the club hosts throughout the year by making a donation in the speakers honor to the *Pledge Against Bullying* program. Along with the donation, a photo of each speaker will be placed on a microSD chip and shot off to the moon.

"the fact that they get to go to the moon is really cool too! It seemed like a meaningful way to say Thank You."

Our own Ken McBride will be singing at the service.


