4,400 deaths through suicide of young people.

14% of students have considered suicide

7% of students have attempted suicide

30% of students are bullies or victims

180,000 kids stay home each day because of bullying

Bullying was a factor in 2/3 of the 27 school shootings reviewed by US Secret Service

This has to stop and this program **does** make a difference,

Leesburg High, attendance up 4%, Reported Bullying up 25%, Awareness up 100%, School fighting down, Academics up, a change in school culture and a student supported program.
