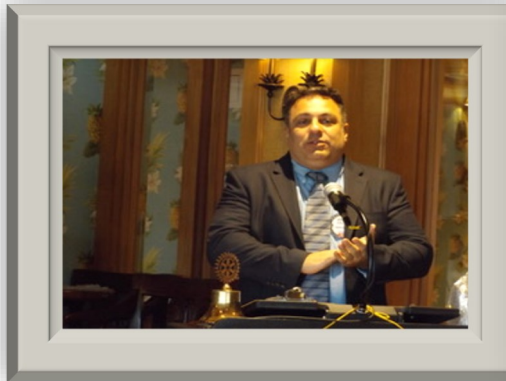

Jeremy Difiore and Doug Mintz were our speakers today .

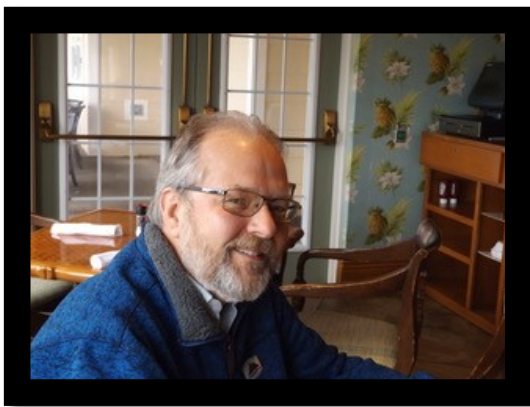
Tony talked about the transition from good times to really bad times and back to his current position of really good times.

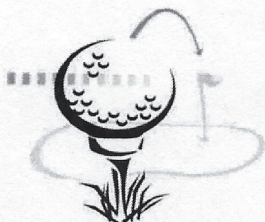

For those of you who know him, Bob Cater,s wife past away, we extend our prayers. Bob is one of our long time snowbird members.

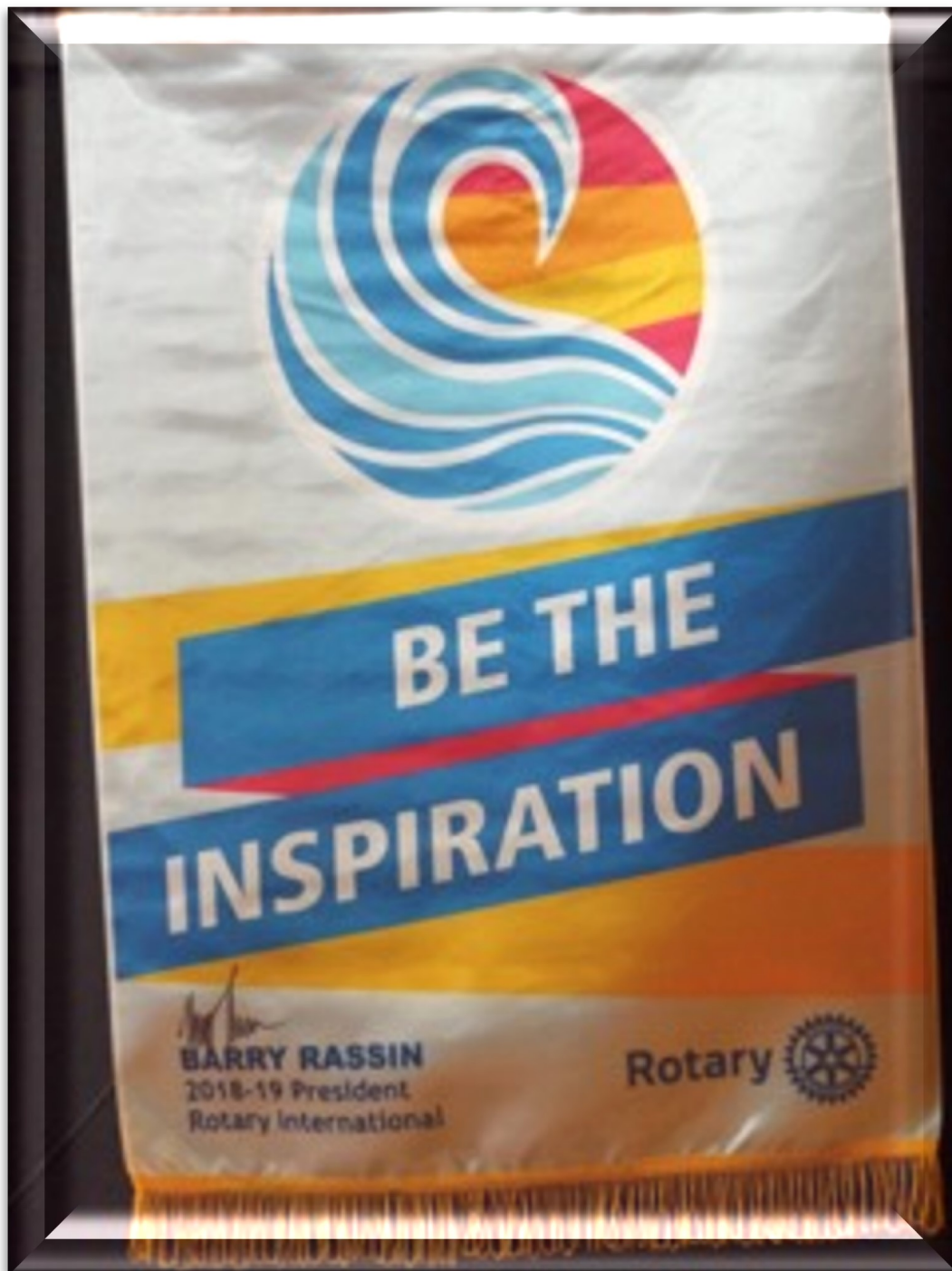
