Meet Anthony Curinga, you might know him as the man behind the camera, for The Roclarion, he was born in May of 1941 in small town along the banks of The Hudson River. A Dutch Colonial town of about 1200 people. One half the population being Irish the other halve being Italian all with roots in a small town in Italy called Cittanova, in Calabria.

Growing up in his house they spoke Italian, English was optional in the house, but not often used, when he did speak English it was with a bit of the Irish brogue.

.Verplanck was a River town and provided great entertainment for a young boy, swimming and diving off the boats He was raised in a General Store owned and operated by his parents at the age of ten he took to soda jerking and general all round helper.

He went to Catholic High School and then on to St. Francis College in Loretto PA. as a premed student.. He was fortunate to be the first in his family to go to college as well as the only one of his peers to go beyond high school. He told about room and board and Tuition being only \$1,250 per year.. Elberg Germany, and after two short months was appointed he was the Clinic Chief of the Dental unit.

Although Pre-Med had busy schedules , he managed to play piano in a jazz band, sing in a choir as well as a chorus, ran a radio studio and was the sound man for the school as well as a few dozen other things.

He then went on to Columbia University and receive his Dr. in Dentistry ,he then joined the US Army Dental Corp, after graduating in June of 1966 he was a n Intern at Martin Army Hospital at Fort Benning GA. After his internship he was given orders for Germany to go to Coleman Army Barracks in Heidelberg.

When he got out he had his own practice and also became a professor at Columbia at the same time. There is so much more to Tony than meets the Eye, get to know him BETTER.
