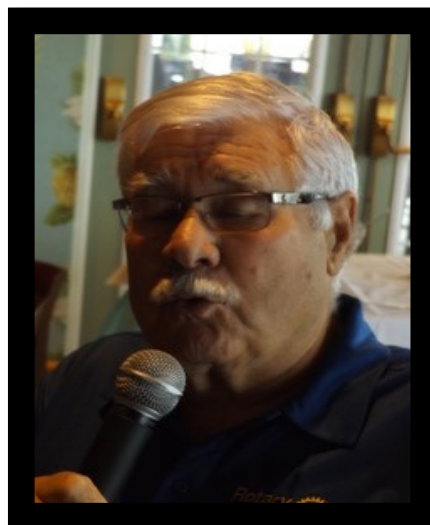
Rotary Means Business , a group going back to the foundation of networking, is starting a group that will meet once a month.

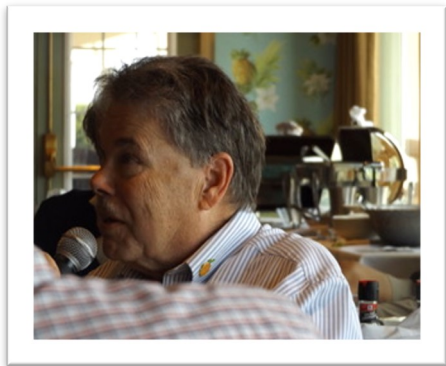


Jeremy Difiore leads us in the “Days thoughts” and Ken McBride leads us in song. To start the meeting today.
