### **Rise Against Hunger**

Tuesday's featured speaker came to us from Rise Against Hunger, a four star charity on Charity Navigator, which is based in Raleigh, North Carolina. Naomi Brisard, out of the Orlando office, offered up a brief history of the charity, and an explanation of the ways Rotary can help and actively participate in their mission, while at the same time working on the mission of the Rotary International Foundation.

Dr. Ray Buchanan, a Methodist minister, and active Rotarian, started Rise Against Hunger (RAH) in 1998, with a vision of ending world hunger by 2030. Realizing that "ending world hunger is more than just feeding people" the organization focuses on feeding programs "in areas where (it) can see transformational development" and where it can expand beyond simple meal packaging and distribution.

To this end, Rise Against Hunger pursues three pathways, first providing millions of nutritious meals to in-country partners who insure proper delivery. Second, RAH provides crisis response to both man-made and natural disasters. Finally, RAH provides grassroots community empowerment to include agricultural education, business skills, market access, and improved diets.

Rotary and RAH have partnered for twenty years, and Rotarians have packed over 30 million meals. Five Rotary districts have each completed one million meal projects, and meal packings have been completed at several Rotary International conventions. RAH is perfectly aligned with the six areas of focus of the Rotary International Foundation.

For those interested, a Rise Against Hunger project at the local level can build image and membership, it can include Interact and Rotoract clubs, and it offers a wonderful hands-on opportunity to all members.


