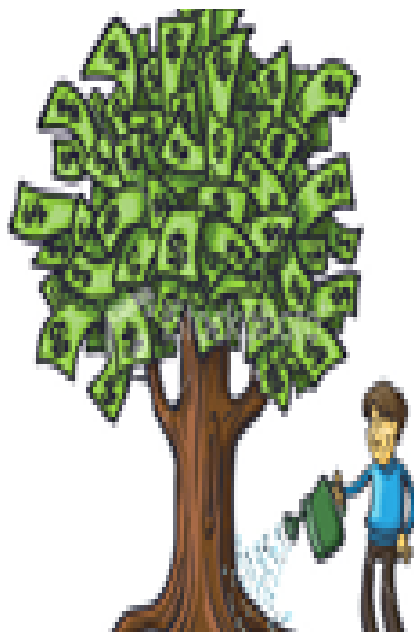

There are approximately 33 cards in the deck, time to get your chance to pick the Joker and win.

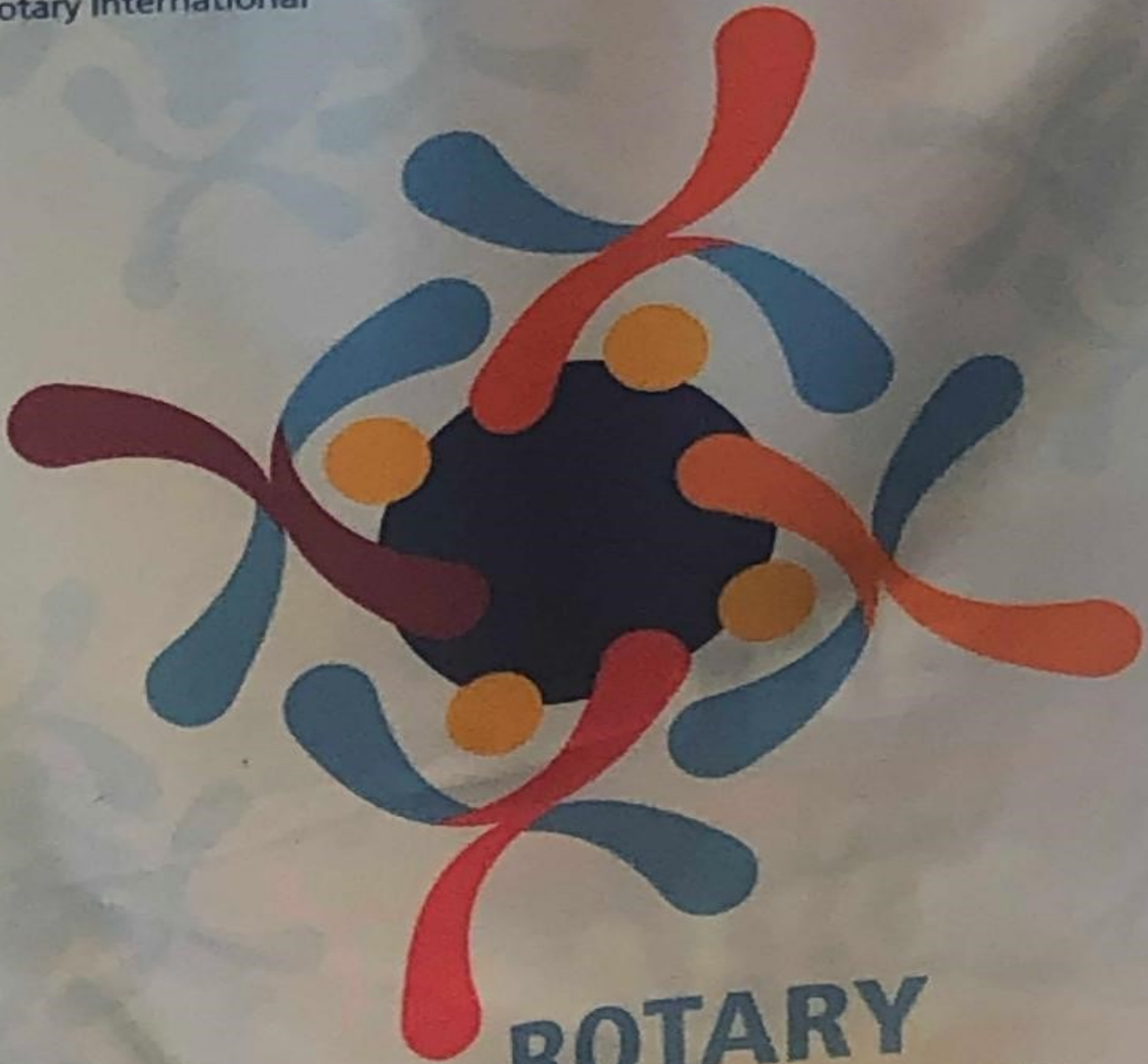
