If you're able to help, please reply to this email. This is set up to send to Rex Dugan. We're happy to have you come for some or all the event.

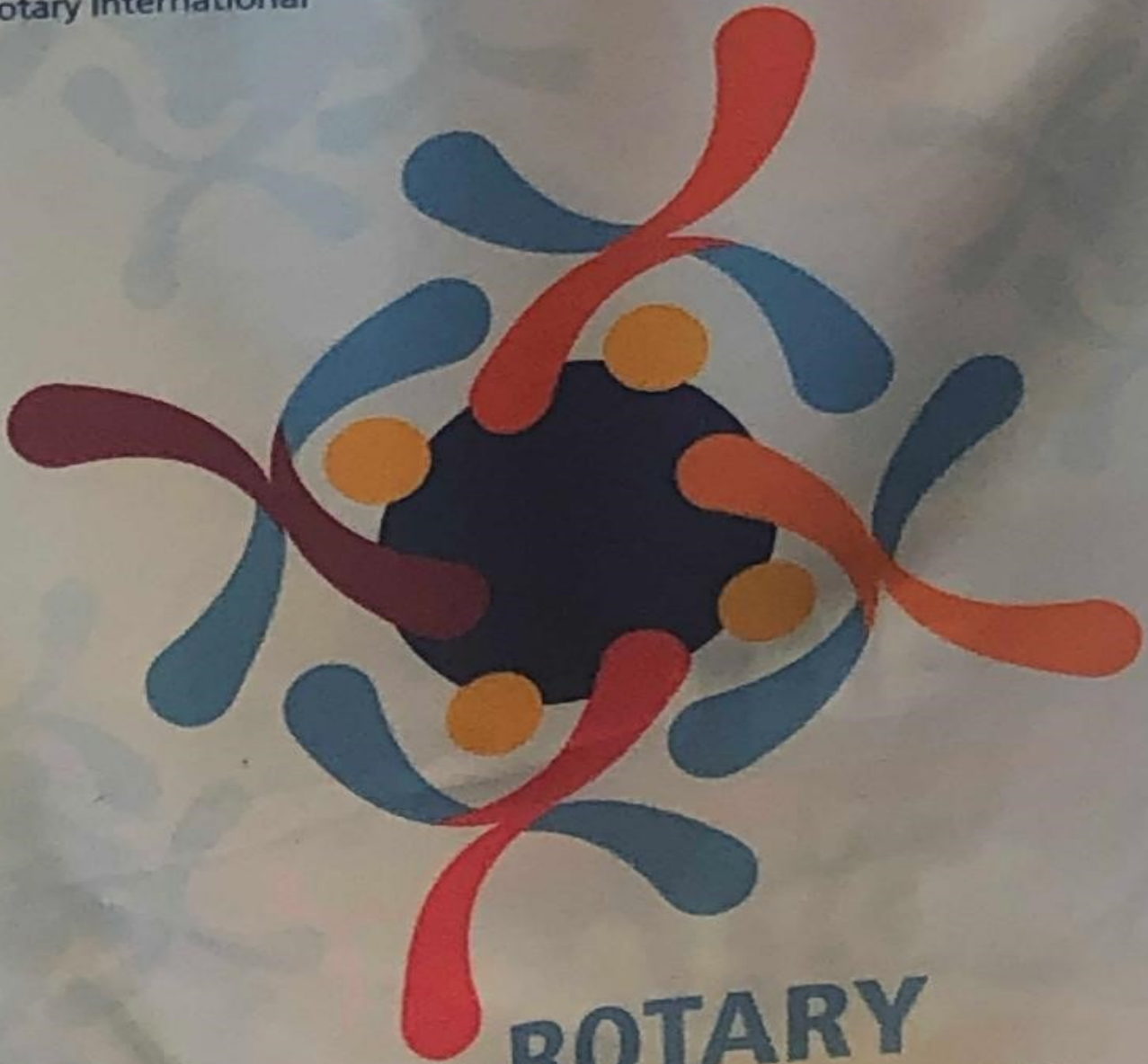
