We would treat them like they were our grandchildren and involve them in our daily lives. A host family is responsible for providing each student with a bed in a room with a door. Provide three meals a day, provide transportation to and from local EHP bus stop or course center, attend a mandatory Host Family Seminar/Orientation. And offer a warm and nurturing home environment.

Students come to the U.S. looking for a unique learning experience combining language and culture. All students are fully insured and have their own spending money.
