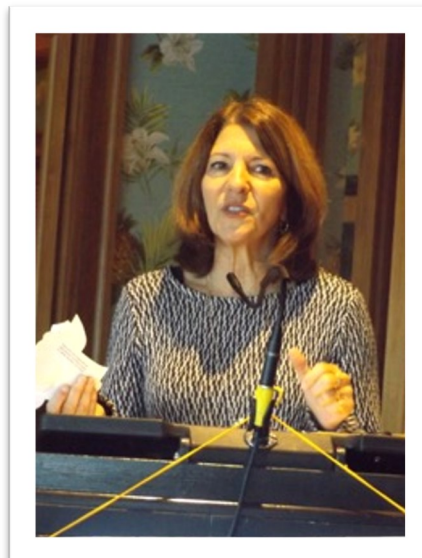
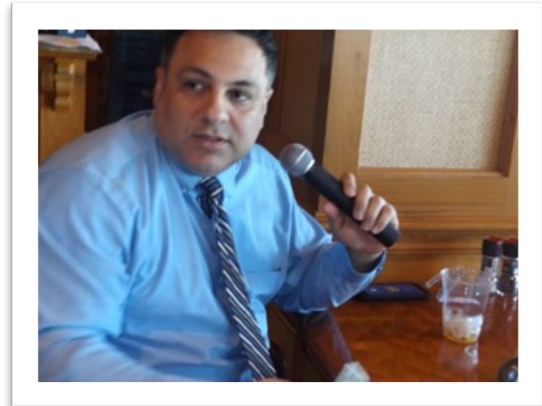
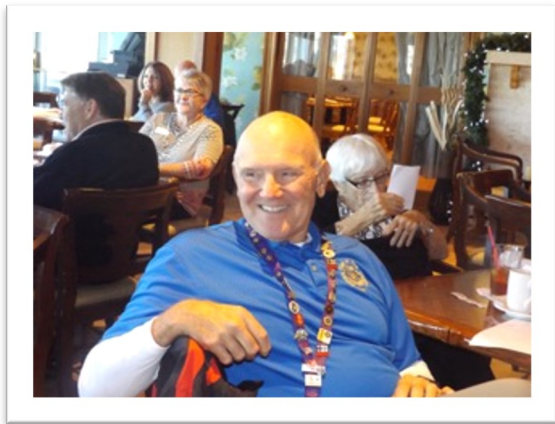


Welcome to our two newest ,as Larry Newman ushers in our newest members ,

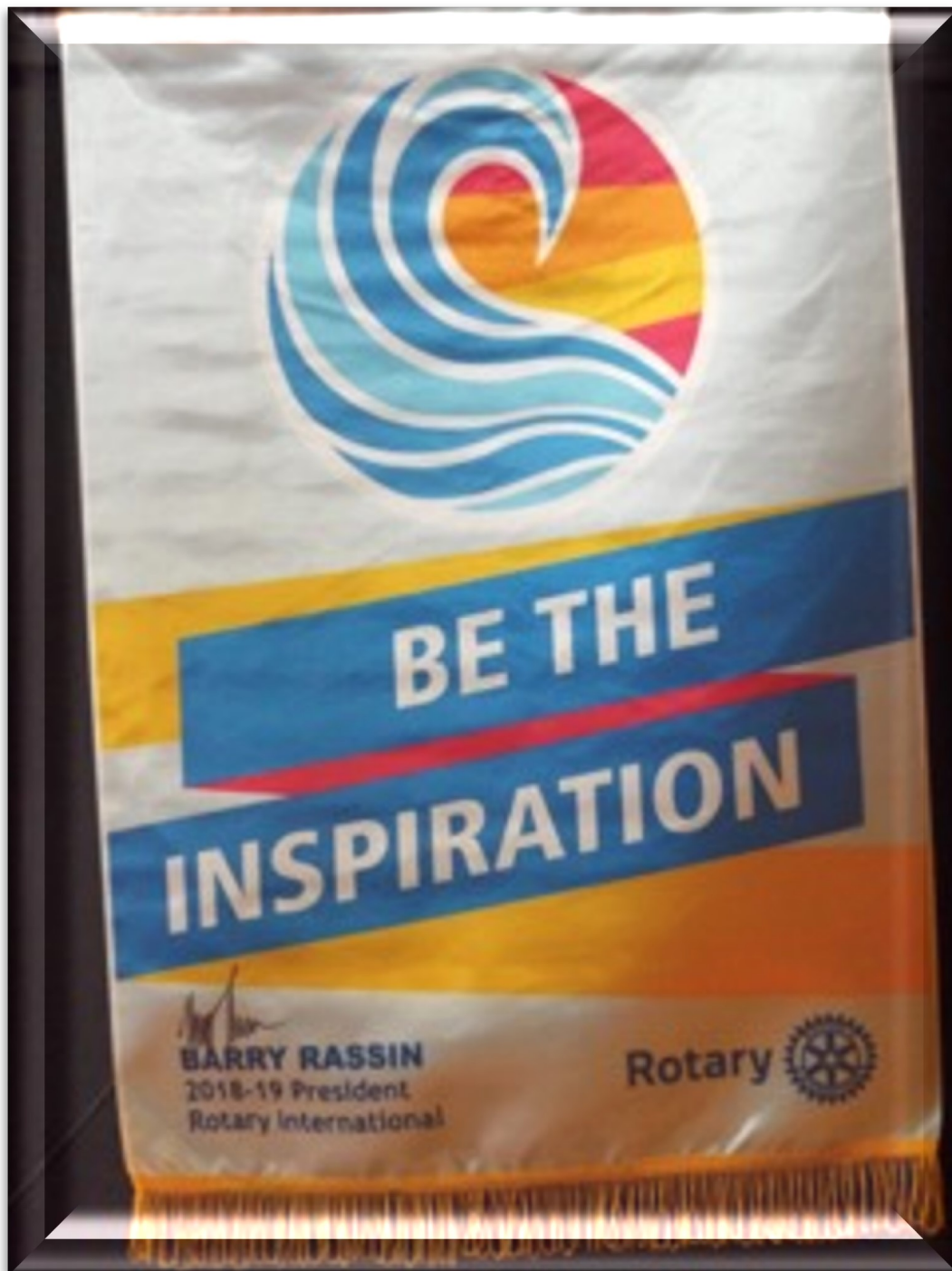
**The Pot Grows and the cards diminish, so if you want to miss a meeting, go ahead, that gives the rest of us a better chance to win.**

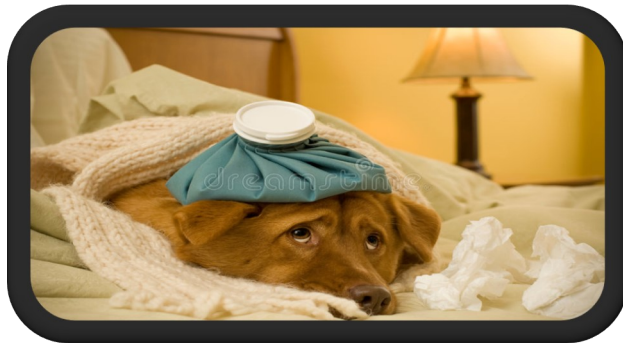
