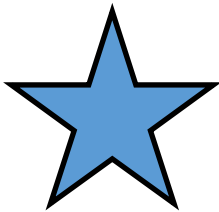
We were please to have visiting with us two lovely ladies from the

. Villages Opera Club , who told us about their work and the upcomming show to raise funds for scholarships.

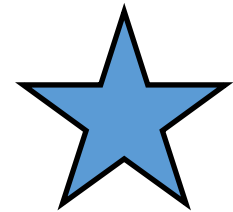

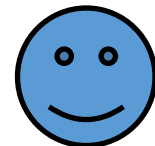

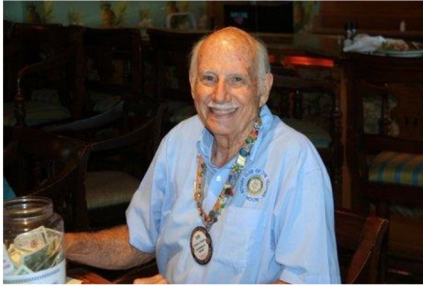
A send off for Past President Donny Abraham

- Members receive the annual newsletter and access to a directory of members and their contact information.

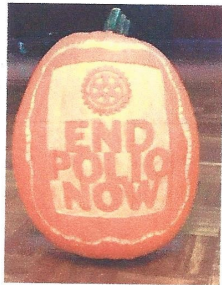

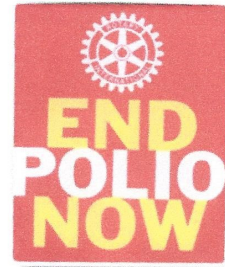
