Her talk was both heart wrenching and heartwarming at the same time , as well as being very informative.

Every two weeks, the La Hacienda Recreational Center erupts with the sound of laughter as hands work back and forth pulling, wrapping and weaving. These hats and scarfs, help to keep Pediatric cancer patients warm in cold hospitals.

Not all the work is done at La Hacienda the project has grown so that other centers are also used, as well as many work at home, not just women but men as well. There is even a location for making the hats in Ocala women's prison.

Jen's lanai is filled with boxes for shipping and storage, The boxes are full of hats etc. are destined for Pediatric wards in hospitals from Alaska to Florida and nearly every state inbetween, as well as Canada. Every one is shipped from the Smiths family lanai .

They have made and shipped over 70,000 hats to over 89 hospitals. She works with more than 150 volunteers.

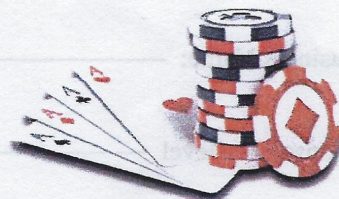

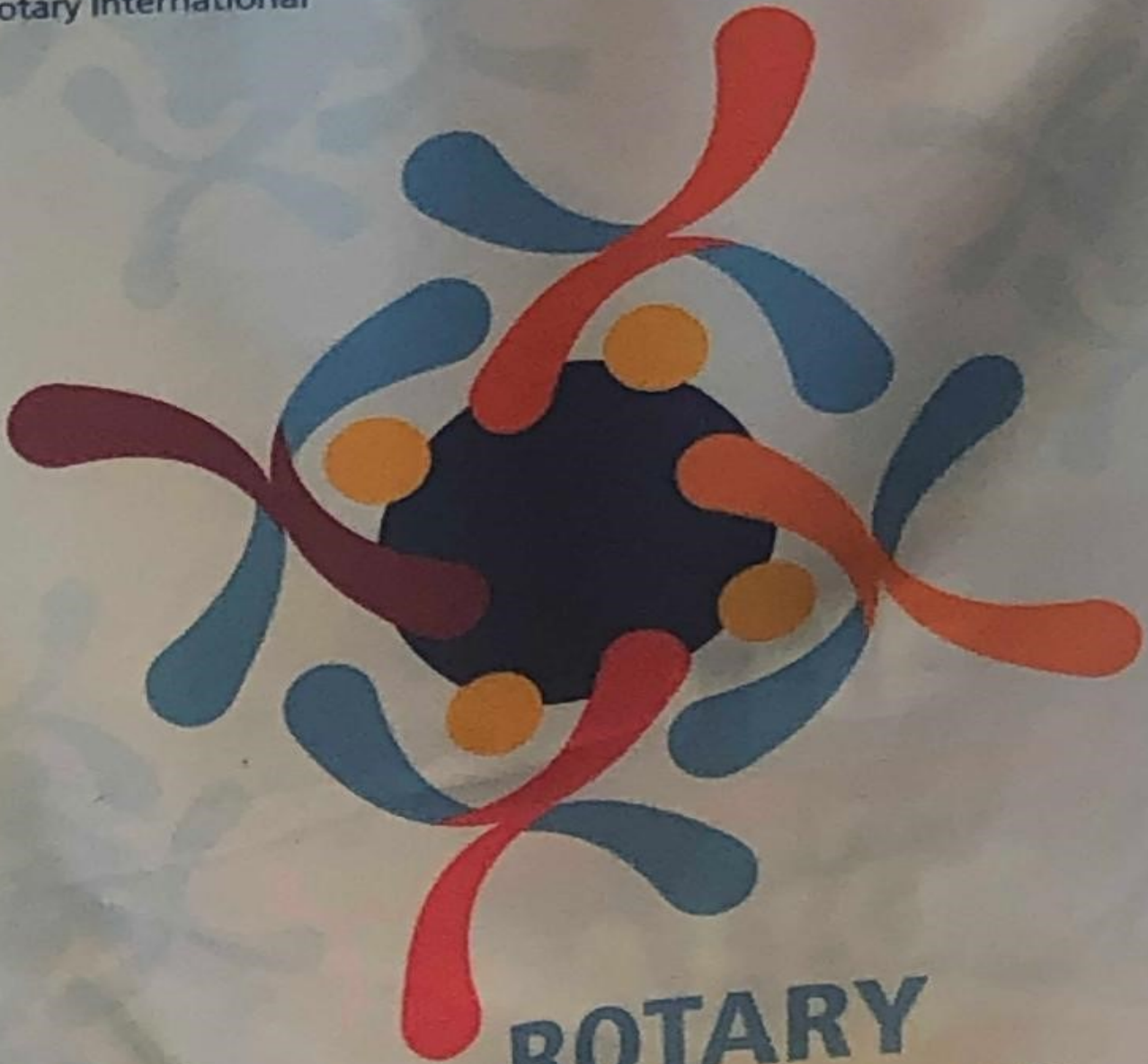
