

Random Thoughts.

"When I gave my farewell address.....I said that the United States did not invent human rights——-That human rights invented America. I still have that feeling. Within us, we have the capacity and the idealism and the history to be a superpower." Former President Jimmy Carter

Millions have been committed to ending Polio.

But our work is just beginning.

We are on the brink of eradicating polio. As of the end of july, only 8 cases were reported this year, the lowest number in history. Ever time a new case is identified, it could be the last one in the world.

Now, we're even closer. At the Rotary Convention in Atlanta in June , Nations from around the world and key donors pledged \$12 Billion to energize the fight against the disease.

And in August The United Kingdom added it's own pledged of 130 Million .

The new funding will go toward Polio eradication efforts, such as disease surveillance, responses to any outbreaks, and the vaccination of 400 Million children annually.

While donors have pledged the money to shrink the funding gap. Rotary's work continues. As apart of the Pledge, Rotary has committed to raising \$50 million per year over the next three years, an amount the Bill and Melinda gates Foundation has committed to matching 2_to_1. We need to raise money to ensure that we take advantage of the full Gates match and pressure governments to come through on their commitments
