There are over 32,000 Rotary clubs in more than 200 countries and geographical areas. Clubs are nonpolitical, nonreligious, and open to all cultures, races, and creeds. As signified by the motto "Service Above Self", Rotary's main objective is service — in the community, in the workplace, and throughout the world.

Membership

Rotary membership is by invitation.

An interested individual first experiences Rotary as a guest. Any member may then submit a proposal for membership on behalf of an interested guest. The proposal is reviewed by the club's board of directors and then submitted for approval to the club. A formal invitation to membership may then be extended.
