ROTARY DISTRICT CONFERENCE - HELP WITH SILENT AUCTION.

Lincoln South Rotary is again responsible for the Silent Auction at the Rotary District Conference May 1 and 2 at the Marriott Cornhusker. We need volunteers to help throughout the conference.

During the day, the conference meetings will be in the lower level - so the Auction Items will be on display in the open area. In the evening, the dinners are on 1st floor so we need to move the items to the Banquet room.

- - Friday during the day (8:00 - 4:00) we could use help when people arrive and bring things for the auction - we will need to record the items, create bid sheets and possibly assemble them before display (then general oversight). These auction items will not be at the Luncheon on Friday.

- - Friday (right after the Business Meeting - before dinner) we will need to move the auction items upstairs; then after the Banquet we will move them back downstairs to the storage room.

- - Saturday during the day (8:00 - 4:00) - start but setting up the auction again (items in storage) and then general oversight.

- - Saturday right after Bingo (approximately 4:00 - before dinner) we will need to move the auction items upstairs; mid-way through dinner we will close the auction and record the final bids. After dinner we will collect money and after that we will store any items not picked up.
