





turned out Friday for Business networking Club Strength- Leave the day which was graciously hosted by Bryan club better than when I Block at Butherus Maser and Love. Attendees were treated to a tour of the facility

and an Italian buffet from Valentinos. Butherus, Maser & Love generously donated the space and the food for the meeting so \$275 collected for the day will be added to LSR fundraising proceeds to be used for club projects.

Bryan gave a short talk about the funeral industry and answered many

questions. The most difficult part of the industry is scheduling. Funeral directors are on call 24/7 and they very rarely have more that 2 days notice that their services will be required. Pre planning arrangements have long been portrayed as taking advantage of customers when in reality when you think about it you are locking in a price for services to be received in the future which is a smart financial move. Preplanning also avoids the many questions that come up later regarding wishes of the decedent such as memorials etc. He showed the group the normal size of cremated remains which fit in a box about the size of a shoe box. 20 years ago about 8% of the bodies

> were cremated but now it is approx 1/3. Burial plots in Lincoln about \$1,000. run Green burials are becoming the new trend where everything is biodegradable. Also stacked burials in the ground are common. One of the more unusual things that he has seen is people who bury the cremated

remains of their pet with them which is more common than you would think.

At the end of the meeting there was a drawing for door prizes. Also in honor of our meeting Bryan carved a pumpkin with the Rotary International Seal!

LINCOLN SOUTH BOARD NOMINATIONS

It is that time of year again when we nominate members of Lincoln South Rotary to serve on the Board of Directors. Briefly, the process is as follows:

Lincoln South Rotary Club Members are asked to nominate members to be put on an election slate for Board of Director to the Club. All members in good standing that are not already on the Board and who have had their New Member Sticker removed are eligible to be nominated (Transfer members are also eligible if they choose even if their stickers have not been removed).

All members are asked to nominate (it does not matter if you are a new member - if you have some people you want to nominate you should complete a nomination form).

The people with the most nominations are asked if they choose to run for election to the Board. A vote among those top nominations will then be conducted and we will elect 3 Board Members to serve a 2-year term (2010-2012).

Election of officer positions is done by the Board after the new Board members are selected.

The attached slate represents the members that are eligible based on their Member Status (not new members); those members that are not new members but are not eligible because they are already on the Board for 2010-2011 are not eligible and are shaded in grey.
