# **PROGRAM**

Charlie Schilling, Assistant General Manager of the Pinnacle Bank Arena gave an overview of the progress at the facility. He, along with the General Manager, Tom Lorenz are employees of SMG Management out of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He noted that the City of Lincoln owns the building - is managed by SMG – and leased to the University of Nebraska. Capacity of the venue for a concert is anywhere from 12,300-14,000 seats depending on the angle of the stage performance. They also have the ability to do a "half house" concert with setting from 4,000-9,000 people.




