YPG has an executive council of 13 members and different tracks of involvement including networking, political voice, membership, marketing, philanthropy, entrepreneurship, education and Ad hoc. Current membership totals in excess of 830, and you can control your level of involvement. The group holds 1 networking event per month and has numerous other initiatives including:

- West Haymarket Arena— Educate and train members to present information to other groups, mobilize members to vote, and mobilized volunteers for the campaign.

- Rallycat Program— Take YPG programming to the workplace with participating companies



- Special Olympics— Raising awareness, volunteers and fans.

- Leadership Training— Quarterly programs in partnership with Leadership Resources

They hope to grow their membership to 1,200 as well as to retain and engage existing members.
