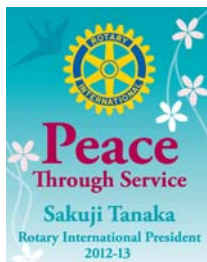

Jamie Henning, with the Lincoln Chamber of Commerce spoke to the club about a project she is coordinating to set a world record in Lincoln. The idea for the project came out of the new branding strategy for the city to get our city recognized nationally. Lincoln is going to try to break 2 world records for stacking Lincoln logs. They are going to try to exceed the highest structure which so far is 10 ft 11 inches as well as exceed the most Lincoln logs with is currently 10,000. The build will take place on April 13 and is expected to take up to 7 hours to finish. When complete the structure will be on display at the Lincoln Children's museum for 5 months for all to see.
