WHO Meeting on Polio—Rotary Leaders recently received a memo from the RI General Secretary discussing Rotary's response to a WHO statement which concluded that the recent international spread of polio constitutes a "public health emergency of international concern". Since the WHO statement is receiving considerable negative coverage in the International press Rotary decided to respond to the statement. Rotary sees this designation by WHO as a positive development which will help to protect and safeguard the tremendous progress achieved since the launch of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative as well as drawing much needed attention to the polio eradication effort. Rotary supports the WHO Director-General's recommendations.

Our speaker was Yuliana IERive and exchange student from Ukraine who is a student at Wesleyan in Education and German. She also was a counselor and speaker at the recent RYLA camp.

Yuliana is from western Ukraine. The capitol is Ryiv, the currency is the Ukranian Hryunia and Ukrainian is the official language. The population is about 46 million and the religion is Eastern Orthodox Greek Catholic.

Recent turmoil in the country has been the result of issues of conflict in language and religion. IN the west and central part of the country, fewer people speak Russian while in Eastern Ukraine, more than 50% speak Russian. This is raised as an issue by politicians but the people actually don't see it as an issue which causes tension.

Young girls are taught to make traditional clothing which is worn for major holidays. Yuliana shared some fun facts including that Ukraine has the 3rd

most visited McDonalds in the world, McDonalds is considered a fancy restaurant in Ukraine, the 1st kidney transplant took place in Ukraine, Ukraine is recognized as having the 3rd most beautiful language, Ukraine used to be the 4th most educated nation in the world but has recently declined in that category.
