- Rotary Foundation Support- \$9,200 for the club (at least \$200/member).

New president Clay Ehlers shared his vision for his year as president with the club. He spoke about the new International Presi-

dent K.R. Ravindran from Sri Lanka who's theme is "Be a Gift to the World". Our new District Governor will be Rod Bates and the Assistant District Governor will be Alan Hersch.

Clay discussed the District Goals for 2015/2016 which include:

- 1. Increase net new membership 3% through recruiting and retention.
- 2. Achieve a minimum donation of \$32/member/club for Polio Eradication.
- Foundation Annual Fund Goals include an increase in participation in Rotary Direct of 10%, 50 new Paul Harris Society Members in the District and \$200,000 raised for the Foundation.
- 100% use of Rotary Club Central to set goals.

Increase awareness of Rotary through traditional and social media.

> Clay then discussed his goals for Lincoln South which include:

- 2. Increase membership 10% through recruiting & retention.
- 3. At least \$200 per member contribution to

the Foundation for a total goal of \$9,200
