PROGRAM

Friday was the annual Changing of the Guard where outgoing president Pat Grewe handed the gavel to incoming president Bob Vrana.

Outgoing president Pat Grewe thanked all his officers, directors and project and committee chairs. (See next page for pictures.) Pat then presented the 2012-2013 Year in Review including our progress on the goals set out at the beginning of the year. We attained the Presidential Citation. While we did not hit the goal of 52 members did reach 51 at one time but have lost some members so we are now at 45. Our goal for fundraising events was \$5,000 and we raised \$3,975 to that goal. We contributed \$830 in Happy Dollars to the End Polio Now Campaign. We had 19 programs on vocational service during the year. And we did have fun.

Pat congratulated the club on winning 4 District Awards including, Best international service project for a medium club, outstanding medium club, presidential citation and number 1 club in the district. He showed a video of many of the projects and events held during the year including Daffodil Days, Dictionary project, Red Cross Collections, Strike Out Polio, Lincoln South Foundation Wine Tasting and Chili Feed and the Holiday party.

Bob Vrana took the gavel and discussed his plans for the coming year. The RI theme for the year is Engage Rotary/Change Lives and the new Rotary International President is Ron Burton from Oklahoma.
