**LSR Foundation Wine Tasting**— The date for the Annual Lincoln South Rotary wine tasting event has been set for Friday September 19th at the home of Tracey McClain. More details to follow.

Rotary Foundation Drive Results—Joe Roberts, chair of the RI Foundation Drive for Lincoln South gave the results of the 2013/2014 Drive. Our club gave a total of \$9,150 to annual programs which equates to \$208 per member and gainis us the #1 spot in the District! 84% of club members gave a contribution and 80% gave at the sustaining member level of \$100 or more. 15 members are using Rotary Direct and having the contribution taken from their accounts either monthly or quarterly. Joe also reported that the club gave \$1,130 to Polio Plus this year. The cumulative all time giving for Lincoln South Rotary is just under\$182,000. Thanks to everyone for your generosity!


## 2014-2015 Club Goals

Brian Christensen of Joe Christensen Inc. printing company was our speaker. The company was started by Brian's dad Joe and has developed into a company with a national footprint. The company prints law reviews for most of the law colleges in the country and in fact does no retail business in Nebraska.

Joe Chris-

tensen first started printing legal briefs which required a very short turn around time and he also printed legislative notices for the NE legislature which were needed in 1 day. He developed a reputation for quick and accurate work and one year when the National Conference of Law Reviews was held in Lincoln, several schools toured his plant and he landed contracts with law schools in other states. The business expanded by word of mouth from the students that publish the law reviews in each school.



The company currently prints for 440 law journal titles. The have over 50 employees, many of whom have been there for 20 to 40 years. They are located at 15th and Adams.

Technology has changed their business dramatically. The number of copies they print has

shrunk but the amount of material that they print has grown. Their work is somewhat seasonal as it is tied to the school year. Their busiest time is Thanksgiving to Christmas and then again in March to July. August and September are very slow until the school year gets started.

Ink on paper is declining especially among young people who like to get their information on line.
