


Foundation Grant Model—The Rotary Foundation has a new grant model. Annually, District 5650 gets funds back from The Rotary Foundation to use for District Grants. Local Clubs can apply for these grant funds which will be used to match money put toward a project by a Club. Lincoln South Rotary was involved in three District Grant applications for the 2013-14 Rotary Year. First, the Rotary Clubs of Lincoln submitted an application on behalf of the Dictionary project. Also, we partnered with a number of clubs on an application headed up by Lincoln East for a Music Playground at YMCA Camp Kitaki. And, we submitted for some grant funds to help with our High School Scholarship program. All three applications were approved - with varying match amounts. Volunteers will also be needed for these projects and you will be hearing more about this as those activities draw near.



ABC'S OF ROTARY:

President Bob Vrana has started a new practice at the meeting of sharing information with the club regarding the ABC's of Rotary. Below is the latest installment:

The Definition of Rotary—

In 1976 the Rotary International Board of Directors was interested in creating a concise definition of the fundamental aspects of Rotary. They turned to the three men who were then serving on Rotary's Public Relations Committee and requested that a one sentence definition of Rotary be prepared. After numerous drafts, the committee presented this definition, which has been used ever since in various Rotary publications: "Rotary is an organization of business and professional persons united worldwide who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations and help build goodwill and peace in the world."

Those 31 words are worth remembering when someone asks, "What is a Rotary club?"
