We were honored to be joined via Skype on Friday with members of

the Tblisi Academia Rotary club in Tblisi Georgia who was the recipient of District Grant funds for a mentoring project. Tamriko Tsintsadze who headed up the project led the discussion.

The mentor project was created last year to mentor the many 2nd generation Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) who are children of IDP's who were displaced when the USSR collapsed in the 90's.

IDP's do not have the normal community and family support groups that the rest of us enjoy so the mentor project helps to mentor the kids about careers in their chosen areas of interest as well as to help them create networks to help them find employment.

The project mentored over 80 students this year. 60 were in Tbilisi and 20 in nearby Telavi. All the mentee students were seniors in college and ready to launch their careers. As part of the project, the students

were taken on historical tours to learn more about their country.

Several of the mentees from the current year were on hand and spoke to the club. They each thanked us for the opportunity to be part of the project.
