ABC'S OF ROTARY— ROTARY MOTTOS

The first motto of Rotary International, "He Profits Most Who Serves Best," was approved at the second Rotary Convention held in Portland Oregon in August 1911. The phrase was first stated by a Chicago Rotarian, Art Sheldon, who made a speech in 1910 which included the remark, "He profits most who serves his fellows best." At about the same time, Ben Collins, president of the Rotary Club of Minneapolis, Minnesota, commented that the proper way to organize a Rotary club was through the principle his club had adopted- "Service, Not Self." These two slogans, slightly modified, were formally approved to be the official mottoes of Rotary at the 1950 Convention in Detroit- "He Profits Most Who Serves Best" and "Service Above Self". The 1989 Council on Legislation established "Service Above Self" as the principal motto of Rotary, since it best explains the philosophy of unselfish volunteer service.

Mark Sibble, insurance and group benefits advisor for UNICO Midlands was our speaker. Mr. Sibbel gave a general overview of the 2014 Health Care Reform. This 900 page law, that was created by 5 different Federal agencies, was passed but was never read in its in entirety by the upper levels of government. And how it has been presented in the media has been either biased or completely wrong in its presentation.

The on-line portal to sign up for the Obama

Care is at www.healthcare.gov. "The Market Place" has not been working well and only about 1 in 10 who have tried, have actually been able to log into the site. Currently no one has been able to actually sign up for coverage as of this date. When they get the site up and working, a person should be able to sign up for Phase I which is to fill out information to actually qualify for the insurance. If a person qualifies, then they will be notified that they can complete Phase II and choose an insurance package. Any financial benefits will be paid directly to the insurance companies and

no money will come directly to the individu-

al. If an individual has the opportunity to be covered by their employees health plan, but doesn't choose to participate, will automatically be disqualified from this option even if the market place coverage would cost less. The earliest anyone could be covered by the government plan would be January 2014 if the site gets up and running soon.

If individuals fail to find some kind of coverage, they will be assessed a 1-2.5% penalty on their income tax form at the end of the year. By the end of the third year that penalty will be 3%. Medicaid,

Medicare and the Advantage Programs will remain the same, but the catastrophic health care insurance will be placed into to the market place plans. After January 1st insurance companies will not be able to ask questions about preexisting conditions or gender related items. Because of this premiums will no doubt be increased.
