Process:

Completed applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee.

The Committee will then personally interview those applicants who meet its criteria.

The Committee will select award winners.

Scholarships will be awarded at a regular meeting of the Rotary Club of Terra Linda on May 6, 2025.

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Awards will be processed and submitted by the Rotary Club of Terra Linda Foundation to the award winner's College/University/Vocational School upon proof of enrollment of their first semester. Students have one-year from award notification to request funds.

Candidates cannot be related to a member of the Rotary Club of Terra Linda.

The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and reserves the right to limit the number of applicants selected for interview and to limit the number and number of awards.
