BACKGROUND

The medical camp is held annually in line with the Rotary Calendar for Family Health Days. In the Rotary Club of Kiwatule(RCK), this event has been held over the years under the theme "Kashanda Ya...".



BACKGROUND

- The RCK medical camp culture is that this event is held to benefit the community of the sitting President's place of origin and/or birth.
- The spirit of the camp in the RCK culture is one of these communities experiencing the power of Rotary in touching people's lives in various facets as organized for each event. This Medical Camp was undertaken jointly with the Rotary Club of Kabwohe.

DELIVERING THE MEDICAL CAMP

The delivery of the Camp was undertaken in four (4) phases namely:

- 1. Planning.
- 2. Needs Assessment.
- 3. Service Provision.
- 4. Post-delivery Evaluation.

Planning

This was undertaken through constitution of the Committee for "Kashanda Ka Ishekye" led by Rtn. Marion Natukunda.

The Committee comprised of subcommittees (Medical, Finance, Protocol, Transport, Hospitality and Special Support) taking oath of office on Tuesday 13th August 2019.



Planning

►The aggregated total time spent at these meetings was estimated at 21hours indicating an estimated 588manhours dedicated to this process by the 28 RCK members and guests dedicated to this role.



Needs Assessment

Needs assessment mission was undertaken in August 2019 in Kabwohe- Sheema Municipality & Mbarara by the Medical & Special Support Subcommittees.

The aim was to establish the service scope for the medical camp, site of the camp, the attendant supporting logistical requirements.

The Mission selected Kabwohe HC IV as the preferred location due to the superior logistical advantages and a scoping array of services including OPD, specialized treatment (cancer, dental) and crosscutting issues (like financial literacy and nutrition).



Needs Assessment

The Needs Assessment Mission was further augmented by a follow through visit by the Public Relations (PR) Team from 26th – 27th September 2019. It focused on charting out the physical outlay of the camp operation, the mobilization of the communities, audio-visual coverage and the branding needs.


