### **Program:**

**Sharon Briere**, Principal at St. Joseph School in North Grosvenordale

St. Joseph School is thirty years old, has pre-K through eighth grade and is accredited through NEASC and NIAC. They have 115 students and raise approximately \$100,000 per year through fundraising. Fundraisers include a Golf Tournament, Octoberfest, Bingo and an Annual Appeal. The school is debt free. They have students from CT, MA and RI. In preK, they set aside four free tuition slots for residents of Thompson. The school offers all subjects and a Before and After School Program, robotics, cross country, soccer, intramural basketball and golf. Community Service is a big part of the student life. They work closely with TEEG, have a reverse Trick or Treat, sing at a nursing home and participate in the Razzle Dazzle Parade. Every day they open with a prayer and the pledge.
