About Loup d' Loup

Ride begins and ends at Izaak Walton, south of Columbus (SW corner of HWY 81/30 Juncture.)

Loup d' Loup is a tour bike ride open to cyclists of all levels covering up to 62 miles of Northeast Nebraska's scenic Loup River loop.

The ride begins and ends in Columbus, making stops through the communities of Duncan, Silver Creek, Shelby, west of Osceola.

At each stop, full supported sags will be available with ample water and food for riders.

All routes will end at Izaak Walton in Columbus, NE where a post-ride celebration with complimentary food and drinks will be available to all ride participants and their families.

Proceeds from this fun ride will benefit the International Rotary's mission to eradicate polio and Royal Family KIDS Camp.



Royal Family KIDS is an all-volunteer, non-profit organization that provides its services without charge to the foster families or social workers.

Royal Family KIDS Camp is a resident camp especially designed for 7-11 year olds who are in, or have been, in foster care. The primary purpose of Royal Family KIDS Camp is to give children a week of positive memories in a Christian environment.

Royal Family KIDS Camp of Columbus depends solely on donations, fundraising, and community grants. Participation in this event can help make a big difference in a child's life!

Ride Details

The Loup d' Loup course has been updated to better support riders and traffic flow. Sags will be located in Duncan, Silver Creek, Shelby and west of Osceola, complete with ample water and food.

Distance options include:

- 14 miles (to Duncan and back)
- 34 miles (to Silver Creek and back)
- 62 miles (to Duncan, Silver Creek, Osceola, then Shelby to Izaak Walton)
