

## **Earning Your Blue Badge**

Earning your Blue Badge is a great way to get involved, meet fellow Rotarians, and learn more about our club. Complete the following activities to earn your Blue Badge.

A Blue Badge check-in sheet will be available at each weekly meeting. Be sure to update it as you complete each activity so your progress can be tracked.

### **Serve as a Greeter or Song & Thought Leader or Clipper**

#### **Greeter**

- Arrive at a Thursday meeting by 11:45 a.m.
- Welcome members and guests as they arrive.
- Help members locate their name badges, if needed.
- During clippings, good news, and fines, assist by collecting the fines.
- The Greeter also reads the presenters bio to introduce them

#### **Song & Thought Leader**

- Share the Thought for the Day during a Thursday meeting.
- Let the Club Administrator know which song you would like played before the meeting.

#### **Clipper**

- Read the clippings at the meeting, ask for good news to be shared
- The Club Administrator prepares the clippings, you just have to read them

### **Invite a Guest**

Bring a co-worker, friend, neighbor, spouse, family member, or someone who may be interested in Rotary to a Thursday meeting or club event.

### **Attend Another Rotary Club Meeting**

Visit and attend a meeting of another Rotary club, either in person or virtually. It's a great opportunity to meet fellow Rotarians, experience different club cultures, and expand your Rotary network.

### **Give Your Vocational Talk**

Share a 15-minute presentation about yourself, your career, and your business or profession. This is a chance for fellow members to learn more about who you are and what you do.

### **Attend a District Rotary Event**

Your Rotary membership extends beyond the Council Bluffs Noon Rotary Club. As a member of District 5650 and Rotary International, you are encouraged to attend district conferences, trainings, and other Rotary events.

### **Participate in a Club Event or Service Project**

Volunteer at one of our club's service projects or events. Throughout the year, we participate in activities such as community cleanups, coat and hat drives, food and book collections, and many other opportunities to serve.
