General Qualifications – A club shall be composed of adult persons who demonstrate good character, integrity, and leadership; possess good reputation within their business, profession, occupation, and/or community; and are willing to serve in their community and/or around the world.

Active Membership – Active Members must meet the above qualifications, as well as live or work within the club’s locality or surrounding area.

Honorary Membership – People who have distinguished themselves by meritorious service in the furtherance of Rotary ideals may be elected to honorary membership.

Classification – Each active member of a Rotary club is classified in accordance with the member’s business, profession, occupation, or community service. A classification describes the member’s principal and recognized business or professional activity, or the nature of the member’s community service activity. The Board may adjust a member’s classification if the member changes positions, professions, or occupations. Clubs shall have a well-balanced membership in which no one business, profession, occupation, type of community service, or other classification predominates.

Diverse Club Membership – Club membership should represent a cross section of the businesses, professions, occupations, and civic organizations in its community, including age, gender, and ethnic diversity.

Attendance – Each person elected to membership must maintain at least 50% attendance, and attend at least 30% of the regular meetings at this club in each half of the Rotary year. Members shall be counted as attending a regular meeting if present for at least 60 % of the meeting; or participates in the regular online meeting or interactive activity posted on the club’s website within one week after its posting. Members missing four meetings in a row may be removed from the membership list unless they have contacted the Board of Directors ahead of time for an excused absence during a short period of time. Make up attendance within the same year may be received by attending another club meeting; present at the time and place of another regular meeting with the purpose to attend but the club is not meeting; participates in a club service project or a club sponsored community event or meeting authorized by the board; attends a Board meeting or a service committee meeting the member is assigned to; participates through a club website in an online meeting or interactive activity; attends meetings of other Rotary recognized organizations such as Rotaract, Interact, etc.; attends an RI convention, Council on Legislation, International Assembly or other RI designated meetings, District Meetings, District Committee meetings or other designated District meetings. Special recognition is received for 100% attendance.

Permanent Badge – A permanent badge is received after attending a club orientation meeting, maintaining at least 50% attendance for six months, serving as a greeter and as an invocator, giving a brief vocational talk, selecting a committee(s) to serve on, volunteer for a service project, visit another Rotary Club, and bring a new member into the club within the first year of membership.
