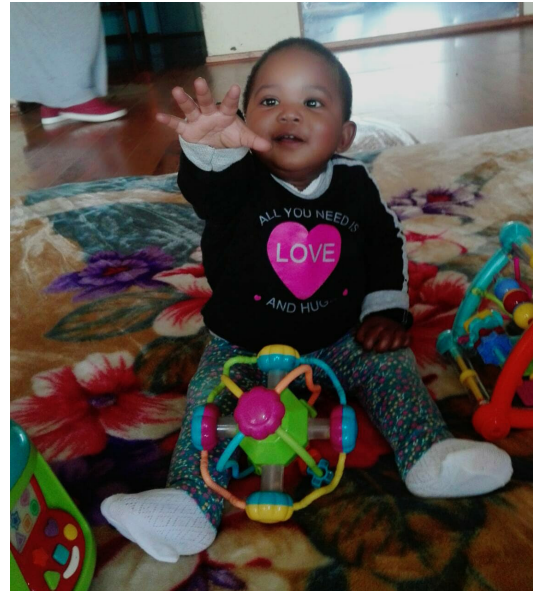
We love Maggie very much and we are very proud of her progress.
