

West Bend Noon Rotary Grant Requests

Guidelines

The West Bend Noon Rotary has budgeted \$7500 annually for local and international grant opportunities. Fifty percent of the total dollars available will be earmarked to fund local requests. Award amounts vary between \$500 and \$3250. Grant deadlines are March 1st and September 1st. The Noon Rotary Grants Committee will evaluate all requests and determine awards. After the September 1st recipients are awarded, the Grants Committee will determine the remaining funds available for the March 1st deadline. Grant submissions must fall within one or more of the following areas of focus.

- 1.) Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution
- 2.) Disease Prevention and Treatment
- 3.) Sanitation and Hygiene
- 4.) Maternal and Child Health
- 5.) Basic Education and Literacy
- 6.) Economic and Community Development

Information Required

- State the project in three (3) sentences or less
- Indicate the Rotary area/areas of focus from the above list
- Include a detailed budget showing all potential and secured funding sources and how all the grants funds will be used.
- You must list measurable outcomes including how many people will be served.
- Explain how the project will be sustained into the future without rotary funding
- Name, signature and contact of person responsible for managing the grant
