REQUEST TO BECOME A DINNER HOUR HOST

What is Project Compassion?

Project Compassion is a fun and easy way for your non-profit organization to raise funds for your deserving local community programs. Denny's Restaurant is providing the Rotary Club of Kona one Sunday evening per month, from 4:00 PM until 9:00 PM, for a Project Compassion Dinner Hour. Each Dinner Hour will be hosted by a deserving local non-profit organization. Denny's will donate 20% of the gross receipts and all tips to the host agency. 100% of all donations collected from this event will be returned to the event host. The Rotary Club of Kona acts as the liaison with Denny's and as the event coordinator.

How can your group become a Dinner Hour Host?

To become a Project Compassion Dinner Hour Host, simply fill out the enclosed application form and mail it to the address specified on the application. Your organization will be required to provide four guest servers and a one or two guest hosts to cover the hours of the event. These guest servers must arrive at Denny's fifteen minutes prior to their shift for training by the Denny's staff. In addition, your organization must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Must be a qualified non-profit organization (501c3 or equivalent)
- 2) Must be Kona based
- 3) Must demonstrate a need that benefits the community
- 4) Must provide one to five event sponsors with donations that total \$500.00 or more, with a \$100 minimum per sponsor. (These donations will be passed along to the hosting organization.)
- 5) Should be ready, willing and able to promote the event amongst your membership and community supporters.
- 6) Must submit a signed application.

That's all there is to it. The Rotary Club of Kona Project Compassion Team will review all applications and let you know if you have been selected and what month you will host a Project Compassion Dinner Hour. You will be notified within one month of the receipt of your application.
