Rotary Club of Colonial Park Foundation ("Foundation") Fire Training/Fireman College Courses/EMS Scholarship ("award").

Purpose and who is eligible

These scholarship dollars are for fire fighters/fire companies in the Lower Paxton and West Hanover Township to be applied towards any fire fighters training program/firemen college credit courses/EMS training courses at Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC). The source of funds for this scholarship is from the Rotary Club of Colonial Park Foundation. The Foundation has received this donation and will be responsible for distribution and follow-up to a qualified candidate/fire company under the following terms.

Amount

The amount of the award is one-thousand dollars (\$1,000). The total amount offered to an individual fire fighter, fire fighter college course/EMS student can be up to one thousand (\$1,000) and can be divided in any of the three categories. The scholarship and is a one-year scholarship program only or until all funds have been disbursed. Scholarships are based upon funds being received each year from the donor and could be subject to change.

Criteria for Award

Individual fire fighters must be a member of a volunteer fire company in Lower Paxton or West Hanover Township. Fire fighters taking college credit courses may apply but must show acceptance or grades from last semester with a 3.0 GPA. EMS students must be accepted into a HACC EMS program or already enrolled must show their acceptance letter or grades from last semester. Fire fighters and EMS students must maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Terms of Award

The Foundation shall consider fire fighters/firemen college courses/EMS students meeting the following criteria:

- Been a volunteer fire fighter for at least one (1) year in the same fire company
- Award shall not apply towards equipment, vehicles or supplies (personal or company)
- Scholarships are for one year
- Individuals must take the training at a HACC campus in the Fire Training, EMS program or college courses offered by HACC
- Individuals must provide details of the program they are requesting admission to and include a brochure of the course or documentation of the course as provided by HACC

If there is no activity in this scholarship award for one (1) year from date student is notified they have been awarded the scholarship, the scholarship will terminate, and no funds will be released from that date forward.

Scholarships shall not be awarded to any member or immediate family member or relative of the Rotary Club of Colonial Park or the Rotary Club of Colonial Park Foundation.

The student/s who receives this award in the Firemen College Course or EMS Program is also required to attend the presentation of the award at a meeting of the Rotary Club of Colonial Park on May 19, 2021. Also, any other meeting of the Rotary Club of Colonial Park requiring the student attendance will be given to the student at the beginning of each semester. Each student will be asked to share with the club what this award has meant to them and provide an update each semester of the student's activities and status in writing.
